

FCG Reflector Conduct Requirements - 17 January 2025

The Florida Contest Group (FCG) reflector at fcg@groups.io is the primary method of everyday communication among FCG members. Membership in the reflector is limited to club members and is a privilege, not a right. Violations of the reflector standards below may result in progressive intervention by the FCG officers, including placing the poster on “moderated” status or suspending the poster’s reflector posting privileges, either temporarily or permanently. (Note: These rules also apply to the FCG’s FL QSO party reflector fqp@groups.io)

- Content of a sexual nature is prohibited
- Content of a religious nature is prohibited
- Content of a profane or obscene nature is prohibited
- Content representing or advocating for, or against, politicians, political positions, or parties is prohibited. This prohibition includes all governmental and organizational politics. We will allow candidates for ARRL volunteer positions within the club’s ARRL circle (Section Manager, Division Director, etc.) to post biographical information about themselves and their plans on the reflector for the benefit of our membership, but we will not permit debate on the reflector between candidates or their proxies, and we will not endorse individual candidates.
- Content attacking or disparaging other individuals, organizations, groups, or businesses is prohibited.

FCG Club Affiliation in Operating Events

When participating in operating events under the FCG banner, participants are representing FCG. The operating event results reporting mechanism for FCG operators is 3830scores.com. Member postings to 3830scores.com are deemed affiliated with FCG if participants specify “Florida Contest Group” as their club. The following apply to comments and operator name, if any, posted to 3830scores.com, or used in the event, by club members:

- Content of a sexual nature is prohibited
- Content of a religious nature is prohibited
- Content of a profane or obscene nature is prohibited
- Content representing or advocating for, or against, politicians, political positions, or parties is prohibited. This prohibition includes all governmental and organizational politics. We will allow candidates for ARRL volunteer positions within the club’s ARRL circle (Section Manager, Division Director, etc.) to post *-biographical information about themselves and their plans on the reflector for the benefit of our membership, but we will not permit debate on the reflector between candidates or their proxies, and we will not endorse individual candidates.
